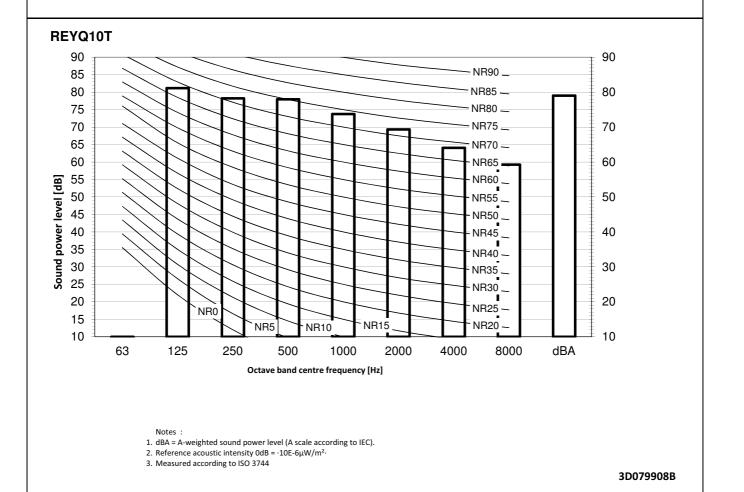


11 - 1 Sound Power Spectrum



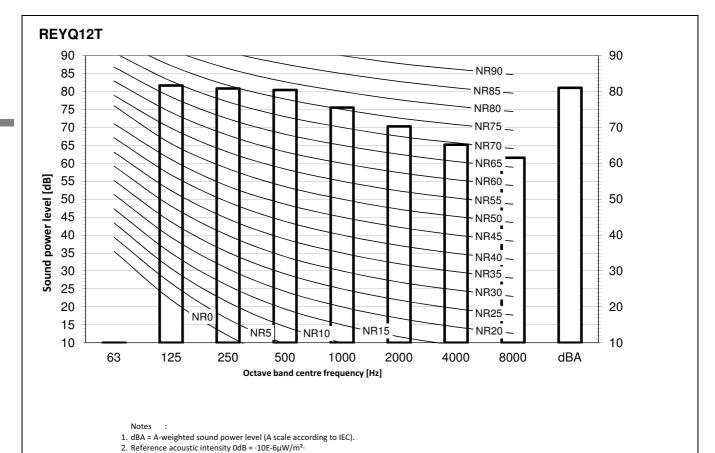

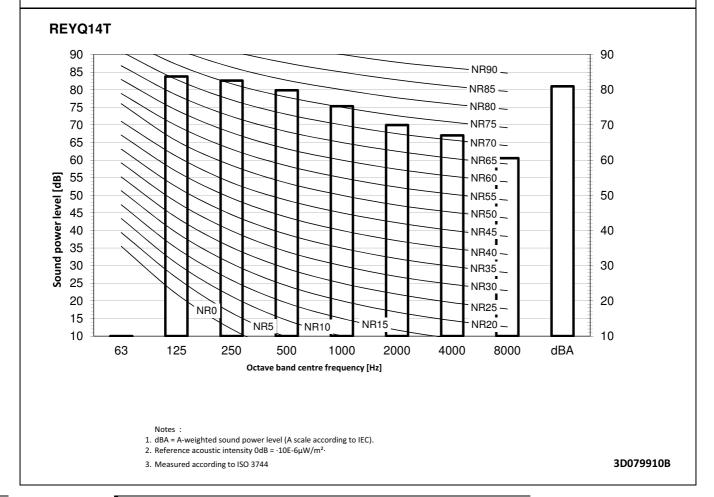


11 - 1 Sound Power Spectrum

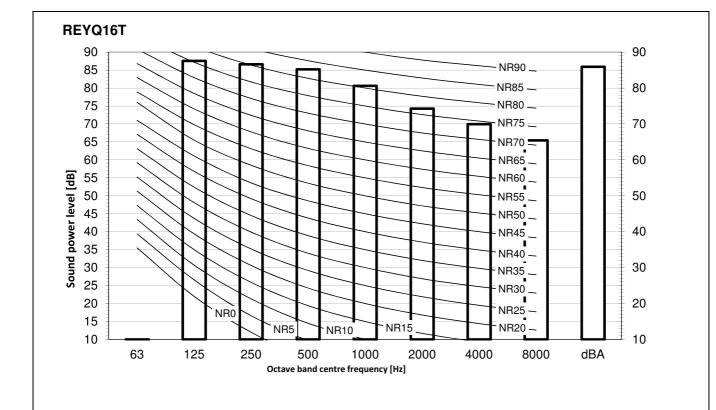

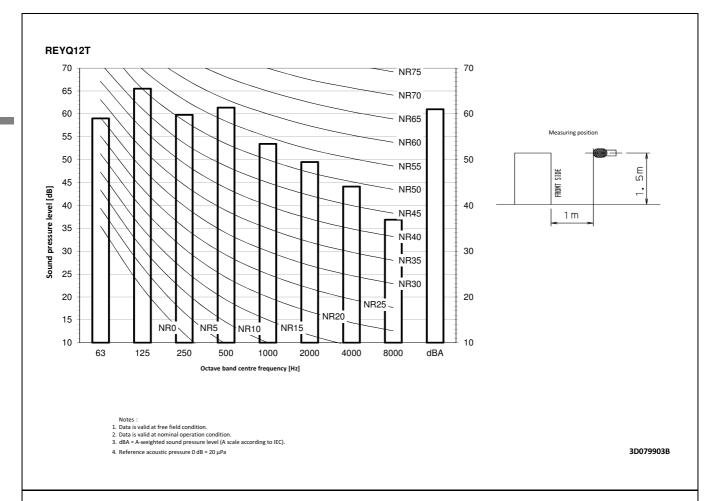


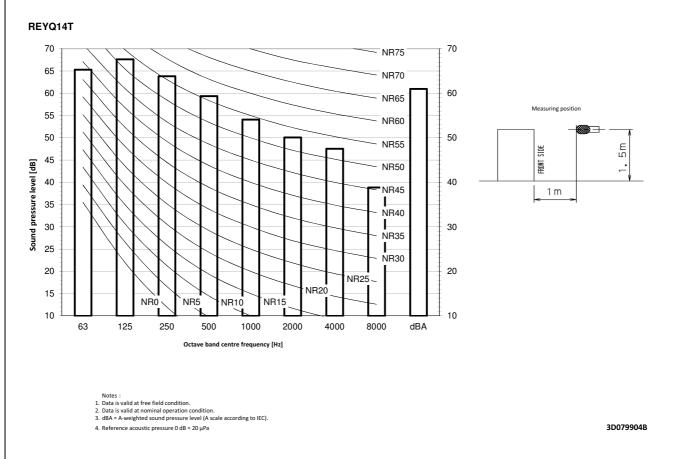
11 - 2 Sound Pressure Spectrum





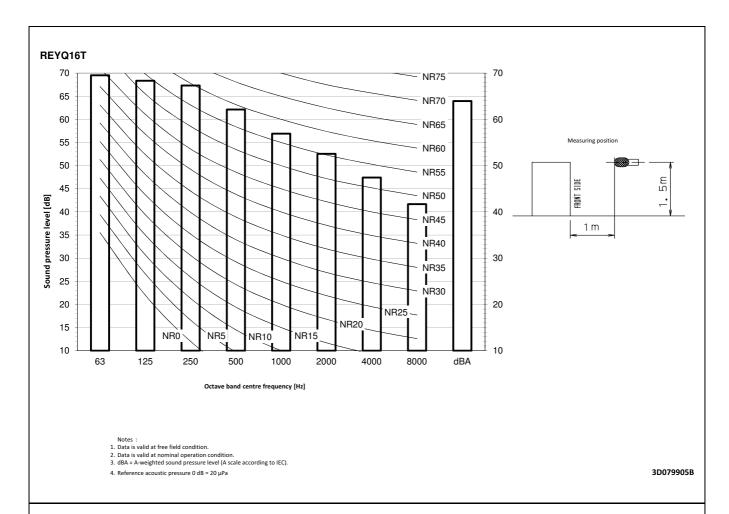

About the piping length

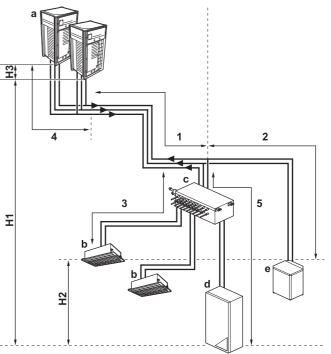
